How Does Thirteenth Street House Work?

Women accepted into the Thirteenth Street House program become residents at its facilities.

The program has two houses that are maintained by the residents, the House Manager, and volunteers. There are seven beds for residents, most in private bedrooms.

The program helps each resident obtain a job within four weeks. This allows her to pay her weekly rent.

Who is Eligible?

Women, 21 years or older, who have successfully completed a substance abuse rehab program, and/or were recently released from incarceration.



What Services Are Available?

- Continued substance abuse recovery
- Supervised structured house
- Individual faith-based counseling
- Medical and mental health support
- Educational and life skills assistance
- Job interviewing skills
- New residents may receive a free physical from Med North
- Clothing is available, if needed, upon arrival

What are the Residents' Responsibilities?

- Daily housekeeping chores
- Laundry
- Personal care
